Paying your Annual Subscription by Direct Debit

Much time and effort is expended every year in collecting members' subscriptions that are the single, most important source of income. You could contribute measurably to the efficiency of running the Society if you were willing to allow it to collect your subscription from a UK Bank or Building Society by Direct Debit.

Direct Debiting is a simple, reliable and economical way to remit your Annual Subscription, and I urge you to complete the Instruction Form which gives authority to The Remote Sensing and Photogrammetry Society to collect your subscription by variable Direct Debit. A variable Direct Debit mandate is important to the Society in its drive for efficiency because it will enable the Society to collect the correct subscription on a specific date each year without requiring you to issue fresh instructions on each occasion that subscription rates change. You will always be notified in advance of any changes to your Direct Debit and you can cancel your instruction at your Bank or Building Society at any time. Annual dates for the collection of Direct Debits are **2nd January** or the **1st April** (depending on whether or not you subscribe to the International Journal of Remote Sensing).

There are no cheques to write, no paperwork or postage and there's no queuing, because The Remote Sensing and Photogrammetry Society can arrange payments for you with your Bank or Building Society.

As Honorary Treasurer of The Society, I invite you to take this opportunity of simplifying your membership payments - and helping us to ease the administrative burden of collecting payments - by completing and returning the Instruction Form as soon as possible.
