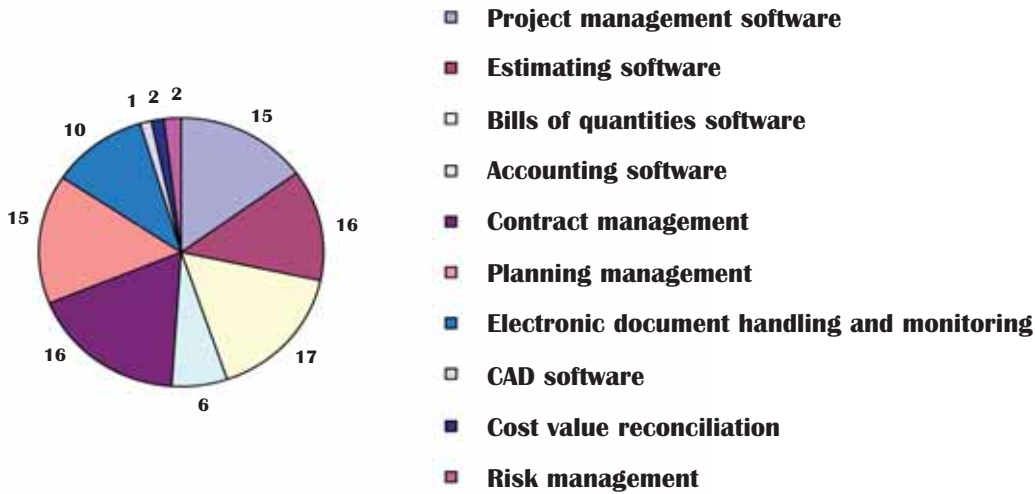

Located within the M25 it is only 10 minutes from junction 10 and 25 minutes by train from London Waterloo or 15 miles from south west London.***



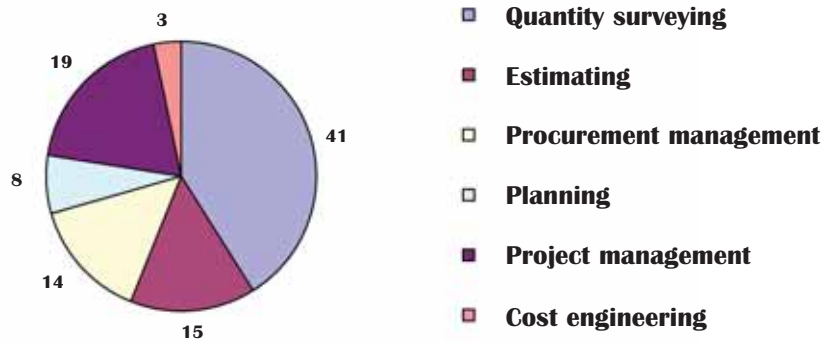
Commercial management member survey on XCES

A survey of the institution's commercial management membership was undertaken recently. Below are the results regarding incorporating commercial management related software into XCES.

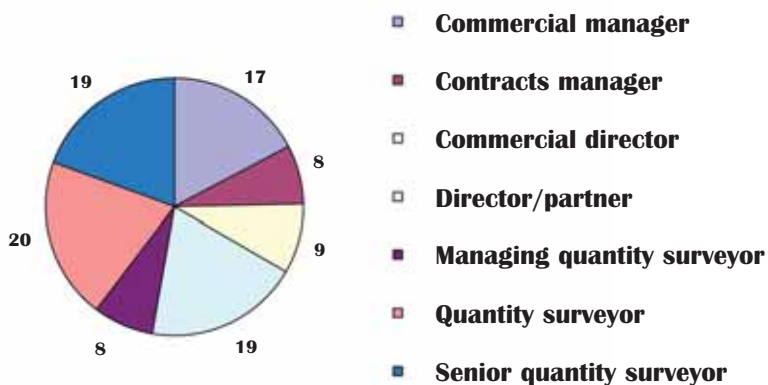
